Phase 2 - Construction Update

Horizonview Drive paving and ADA sidewalk ramps mark completion of the project overall

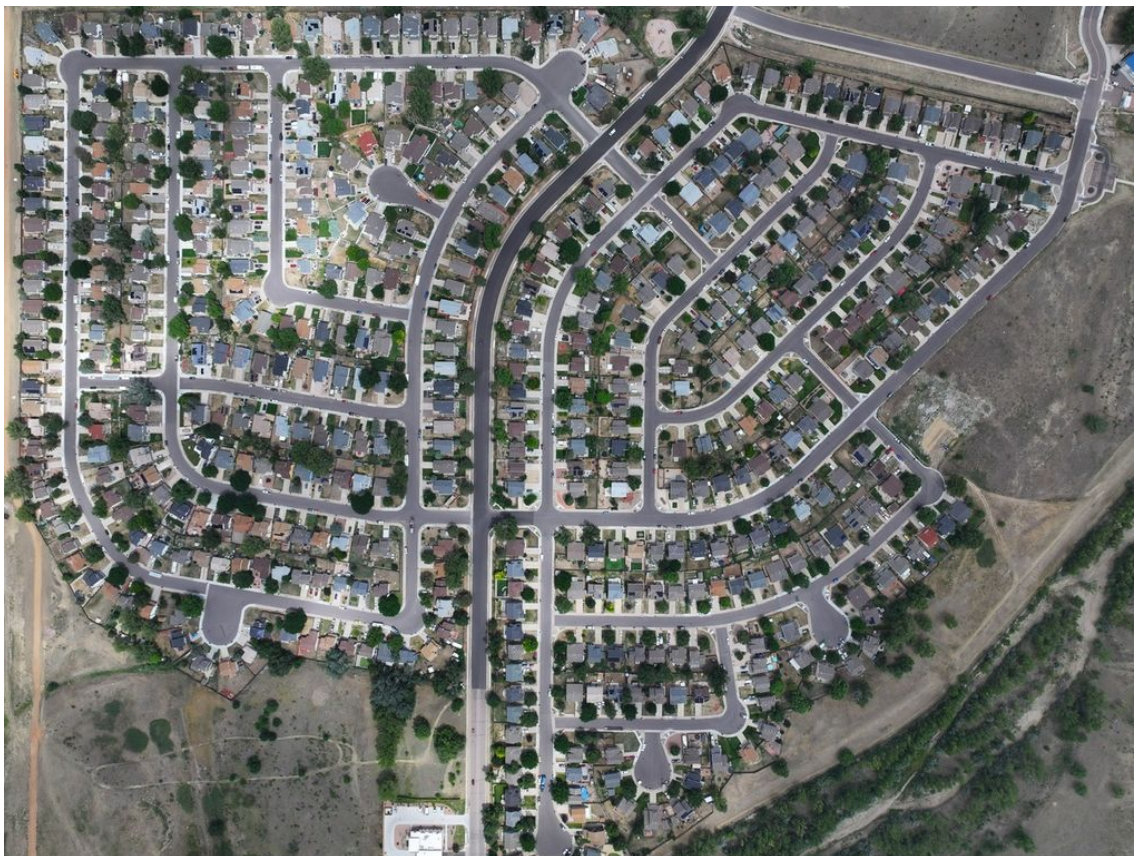
Crews have completed all pedestrian ramp replacements and paving of Horizonview Drive as part of the Colorado Centre Improvements project. This work marks the completion of the project overall.

During the project :

- 4.5 miles of roadway was reconstructed, adding new road base and asphalt.
- A total of 4,000 feet of new underground storm pipes and 19 inlets have been installed to improve drainage in the area.
- Over 6,000 feet of curb and gutter were replaced to improve drainage along the new roads.
- A total of 54 pedestrian curb ramps were reconstructed, along with more than 4,000 feet of sidewalk, to enhance pedestrian accessibility.

We appreciate the public's patience during the summer construction and throughout the project overall.
