



Colorado Centre Drainage Improvements

Paving Update August 4, 2025

Additional road paving operations start the week of August 11, 2025

Paving operations starting the week of August 11 are weather and resource dependent. **Road prep work has already begun in the described paving areas.**

Additional Paving Operations Include:

- Gunbarrel Drive just north of Jackrabbit Lane up to just south of East Anvil Drive.
- Pony Gulch Way starting at the intersection of East Anvil to the Bronco Gulch Court cul-de-sac.

Previous Paving Areas Include :

- Bramble Lane starting at the intersection of Granger Lane up to Chieftan Drive.
- Chieftan Drive west to the cul-de-sac at Levi Lane.
- Levi Lane cul-de-sac north to just west of the Horizonview Drive intersection.
- East Anvil Drive just south of the Granger Lane intersection.
- Pony Gulch Way to just west of the Bronco Gulch Court cul-de-sac.
- Jackrabbit Lane starting at the intersection of Gunbarrel Drive up to the intersection of Pony Gulch Way.

Lane reductions will be in place throughout paving operations. Residents are advised to follow the construction signage and directions of flaggers as only one lane of traffic will be open while paving is underway.

A ramp will be in place at every residence impacted to maintain property access during paving operations.

Utility Work Reminder:

In the upcoming weeks, flaggers and temporary road closures will be present on Anvil Drive in the eastern neighborhood as utility services are relocated before pipe crews arrive to install storm lines. We anticipate completing the storm line installation on Anvil by early September. The affected area will be on Anvil from between Settlement Way and Prairie Fox Lane, concluding at the eastern corner of that intersection. Expect disruptions to the sidewalk on the north side of Anvil.
