SUBJECT: RESOLUTION TO RECOGNIZE REVENUE AND APPROPRIATE EXPENDITURES FOR CONTRACT FUNDING

RESOLUTION OF THE EL PASO COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH

WHEREAS, the mission of El Paso County Public Health is to promote and protect public health and environmental quality across El Paso County through people, prevention and partnerships; and

WHEREAS, the vision of El Paso County Public Health is for all El Paso County residents to live in thriving communities where every person can achieve optimal health; and

WHEREAS, El Paso County Public Health applied and was selected for a Smoke-Free Multi-Unit Housing and Integrated Cessation Support grant to implement a community-based cessation initiative. In collaboration with Homeward Pikes Peak (HPP) and Greccio Housing, the project seeks to reduce tobacco use and secondhand smoke exposure among residents of supportive and affordable multi-unit housing by embedding trained resident tobacco cessation connectors within participating housing communities; and

WHEREAS, El Paso County Public Health received a notice of award to implement this initiative in the amount of \$180,000 for the state fiscal year contract period of July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027; of the total, \$90,000 will be recognized in 2026 and the remaining amount of \$90,000 will be recognized in the 2027 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the El Paso County Board of Health does hereby recognize revenue and appropriate expenditures in the amount of \$90,000 to the El Paso County Public Health 2026 budget in the following manner:

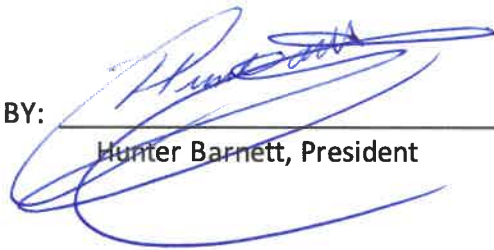
