2021 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Housing in El Paso County, Colorado

The El Paso County Economic Development Department and the El Paso County Housing Authority (EPCHA) administer EPCHA Housing Trust Funds, Private Activity Bonds, and Down Payment Assistance through the Turnkey Plus Program.

EPCHA Housing Trust Fund



\$300,000 was loaned to DBG Properties for the Academy Heights project, a **200** unit affordable housing complex located on Fountain Boulevard and Academy Park Loop.



EPC Private Activity Bonds

EPCHA Down Payment Assistance - Turnkey Plus




96 families throughout El Paso County were able to buy a home in 2021 through the down payment assistance provided by Turnkey Plus.



\$1,403,882 in down payment assistance was provided which helped bring an additional **\$31** million in home loans to our community.



98% of them were first-time homebuyers and they received, on average, just over **\$14,600** to help them purchase their first home.
