



COMMERCIAL AERONAUTICAL ZONE

El Paso County, the City of Colorado Springs, Pikes Peak Rural Transportation Authority (PPRTA), and the State of Colorado are dedicated to attracting local businesses and helping them thrive at the Colorado Springs Airport through tax savings. By resolution adopted by the Board of County Commissioners, the sales tax from El Paso County is rebated for businesses specifically engaged in a variety of aeronautical activities within the Commercial Aeronautical Zone. Eligible businesses must complete a Business Enhancement Program Agreement. Once approved, businesses are required to maintain receipts and submit for rebate on an annual basis.

TAX BENEFITS

El Paso County will provide a credit back to eligible businesses on an annual basis in the following amounts:


Within the Airport CAZ:

One-hundred percent (100%) of the County's one percent (1%) general sales tax collected for eligible activities



Within CAZ but not on the Airport:

Fifty percent (50%) of the County's one percent (1%) general sales tax collected for eligible activities
