

HOUSING PROGRAMS IN ACTION

The El Paso County Housing Authority provided a \$500,000 Housing Trust Fund loan for the Sunrise at Shiloh Mesa development.

In response to the increasing need for Senior housing, all 50 units will be provided with rents at no more than 50% of the area median income.
