PLANNING & PERFORMANCE

The County creates an annual plan to prioritize CDBG funding based on community input from non-profits, social service agencies, and organizations serving LMI individuals; integration of relevant planning documents; and published annual performance reports.

CONSOLIDATED PLAN GOALS

All projects receiving CDBG funds must align with the 2022-2026 Consolidated Plan goals:

HOUSING GOALS



- Improve access to transportation services and infrastructure, remove impediments to mobility and increase access to opportunities.
- Rehabilitation of preexisting housing inventory to increase affordable, accessible housing choices.
- Increase fair housing education, outreach, and enforcement.

HOMELESSNESS & SPECIAL NEEDS



COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT



- Assist in ensuring that homelessness is brief, rare, and non-recurring.
- Help special needs residents obtain housing and remain housed while living independently as they choose.
- Reduce accessibility barriers (ADA compliance).
- Provide for and improve access to services to stabilize living situations and enhance quality of life, particularly for seniors, youth, and special needs populations.
- Improve infrastructure to foster accessible and livable neighborhoods and improve access to public amenities.
- Develop or improve facilities that provide services to low- to moderate income residents and specials needs populations.
- Expand economic opportunities for low- to moderate-income residents.
