If the submittal arrives late, it will not be included in the electronic lockbox.

1. Q: Is there an opportunity to submit equivalent LED fixtures for item no. 619-13000 for review and approval?

A: Plans and specifications do not identify a certain fixture to be used. The item needs to meet all criteria stated in the 2021 CDOT Standard Specifications Section 613 and CDOT Standard Plan S-613-1 included in the plan set.
