



## Colorado Vehicle Registration Renewal

Colorado State Law requires residents to pay late fees not to exceed \$100 and back ownership tax if payment is not received by the last day of the grace period month. C.R.S. 42-3-112 & 42-3-114

## Pay By Mail

1. Mail this card and check to address on front of card.
2. Make check payable to: **El Paso County Clerk & Recorder.**  
*Please include your driver's license and license plate numbers on check.*  
*Do not send cash when paying by mail.*
3. Insert check and proof of emissions or Colorado insurance if required (see front).  
**Seal envelope, affix adequate postage and mail.**



## Pay Online

*See front for emissions and insurance if required.*

1. Go to [mydmv.colorado.gov](http://mydmv.colorado.gov).
2. Have your Renewal Card and credit/debit card, or checking account information to enter as prompted.

You will receive your renewal sticker in approximately 14 business days.

## Pay By Phone

*See front for emissions and insurance if required.*

1. Call (719) 520-6240, press 6 to renew by phone.
2. Have your Renewal Card and credit/debit card, or checking account information available.
3. Credit/debit card, or check must be in the same name as on vehicle registration.

You will receive your renewal sticker in approximately 14 business days.

Pursuant to C.R.S. 42-4-1409 motor vehicle insurance coverage is compulsory in Colorado.

**CHANGE OF ADDRESS:** If you moved within El Paso County visit [mydmv.colorado.gov](http://mydmv.colorado.gov) to update your address. If you moved outside of El Paso County contact your new county for renewal instructions.

If you no longer own this vehicle, complete the release of liability at [mydmv.colorado.gov](http://mydmv.colorado.gov) and disregard this notice.
