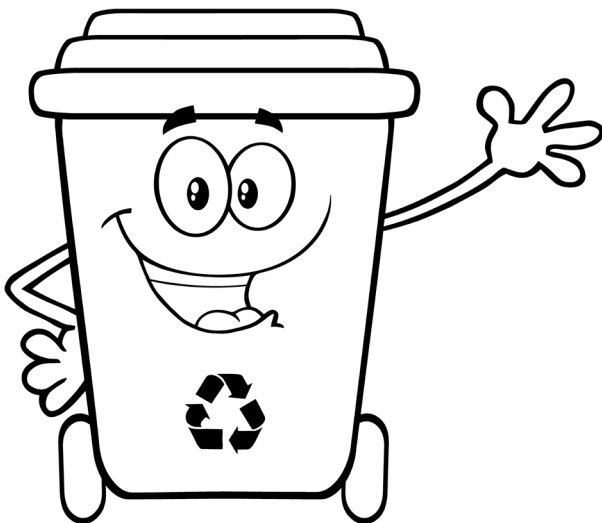

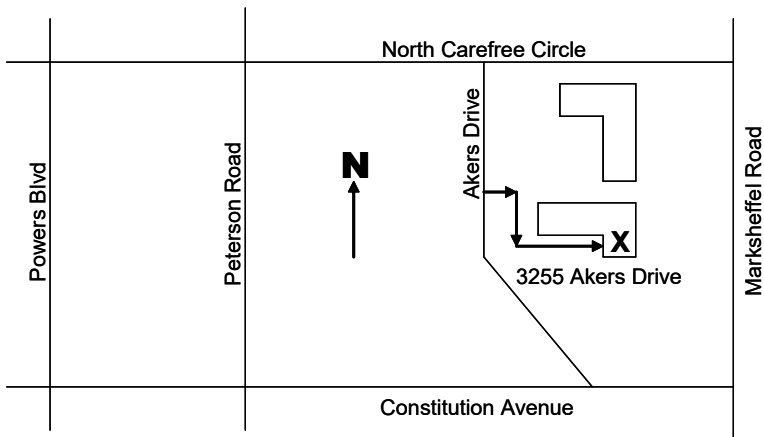

To ensure the safety of staff and protect the personal property of customers, staff will not enter your vehicle. All individuals bringing household hazardous waste are required to remove each item from their vehicle and place them onto a cart. Ensure that someone in the vehicle can accomplish this.

Per the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), El Paso County will provide a reasonable accommodation to qualified individuals with a disability who need assistance, unless doing so would impose an undue hardship to the County or fundamentally alter services. (*ADA placard or plate must be present for services*). Services can be arranged with at least seven (7) business days' notice by calling 719-520-7878 or emailing evs-epc@elpasoco.com. "Walk-in" requests for auxiliary aids and services will be honored to the extent possible but may be unavailable if advance notice is not provided.

El Paso & Teller County household residents ONLY (Proof of residency is required)

Paint totaling more than 50 gallons and / or a large load of hazardous waste items **requires** pre-approval. (half pickup truck bed or more, trailer load, 50+ items etc.)

CHEMICALS

Paint, Stain, etc.

Latex, oil-based, hobby paints, stains. *Limited to 50 gal per household, per year.*

Lawn & Garden: Lawn and houseplant fertilizers, herbicides, insecticides, rodent poisons, wood preservatives, etc.

Household: Aerosols (remove lids/nozzles), ammonia, batteries (household only. No corrosion/leaking. Must come in clear resealable bag no larger than 1 gal), bleach, cooking / lamp oils, cleaners (carpet, drain, oven, toilet), fire extinguishers, fireworks, fluorescent tubes, furniture polish/wax, lacquers, mace, mercury, nail polish & remover, perfume, pepper spray, propane tanks (1-lb & 20-lb), strippers, solvents, thinners, varnishes.

Automotive: (*No tires – see “Tires” page*) Antifreeze (limited to 5 gal/mo), Auto batteries, brake / transmission fluid, cleaners (bug / tar, chrome, engine, vinyl, fuels, wax, etc.), fuels, motor oil, oil filters. *Used motor oil, transmission fluid, brake fluid is limited to 5 gallons [by volume] per customer per appointment per month. All must be separate from each other, must come in containers that are NO larger than 5 gallons. Five-gallon container may only be filled ¾ full and all containers must be left onsite. (Fuel containers may be returned at technician’s discretion).*

ELECTRONICS

TVs (*CRTs must be 20” or smaller diagonal screen; flat screens 40” or smaller diagonal screen*), central processing units (CPUs), computer monitors, keyboards and mice, printers, fax machines, laptops, notebooks, ultra-books, net books, electronic tablets, DVD players, VCRs, radios, stereos, video game consoles, video display devices with viewing screens greater than four inches diagonally. (*Each type of electronic is limited to 5 per household per year*).

MEDICAL SHARPS Must be in a certified red medical sharps container **no larger than 2.2 quarts** (can be purchased from a pharmacy). No more than two containers per household per month.

NOTE: Waste must be in labeled, sealed, non-leaking containers that can be left onsite.

VERY SMALL QUANTITY GENERATORS **(VSQG)**

**El Paso County Household Hazardous Waste Facility
accepts waste from Very Small Quantity Generators. ***

"Very small quantity generators of hazardous waste generate no more than 100 kilograms (about 220 pounds or 25 gallons) of hazardous waste, and no more than 1 kilogram (about 2.2 pounds or <1 quart) of acutely hazardous waste in any calendar month AND never accumulate more than 1000 kilograms of hazardous waste or 1 kilogram of acutely hazardous waste on-site at one time." [40 Code of Federal Regulations 262.14]

businesses, churches, local governments, non-profits, rental
properties, and schools.***

- **Glass:** Food & Beverage only (no lids/corks)
- **Aluminum Cans**
- **Metal Cans** (must discard paper)
- **Newspaper**
- **Office Paper:** No shiny paper (such as wrapping paper), no paper smaller than 8 ½ x 11"

- Maximum size: 6 feet long, 8 inches in diameter
- Loads MUST be securely tied in transit
