


PAINT MINES INTERPRETIVE PARK Commercial/Night Time Photography Permit Information

A permit is required for any individual, business, or organization (including nonprofit groups and educational institutions) conducting photography for a market audience and/or receiving compensation associated with footage made to include financial gain from the photo shoot or the images (using them on your website or social media) to promote a business etc.

Please be advised that we do <u>not</u> allow weddings, concerts, or video/music video shoots.

Props are limited to handheld props only. No tables, chairs, arches, etc.

If you are interested in a permit, please apply a minimum of <u>10 days</u> prior to your requested event date.



- After the **permit application** has been received it will be reviewed by staff.
- The number of people in the group is not to exceed 10 people.
- Once the event has been pre-approved, a Special Facility Use Permit will be e-mailed to you.

The following must be agreed upon in writing:

- Entering the Paint Mine formations is prohibited
- Climbing, standing or sitting on the formations is prohibited
- Drones are prohibited
- After all requirements below are completed, the permit will be issued.

The following requirements must be completed prior to requested photography date:

- > Special Facility Use Permit Fee: \$100/per permit / per day paid via Credit Card.
- Damage Deposit: \$50 (may apply)
- ➤ Certificate of Insurance: A certificate of insurance in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000 for personal injury and property damage (combined single limit) must be on file. The certificate must name *El Paso County* as additional insured and indicate the dates, times, location and nature of the event.
- ➤ <u>OR</u> Waiver Form (depending on the nature of the photo shoot). All participants must sign the waiver. The waivers must be received by El Paso County Parks 5 days prior to the event date.
