**RESOLUTION TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 96-3 RELATING TO THE  
CONTROL AND PREVENTION OF GRAFFITI IN THE UNINCORPORATED  
TERRITORY OF EL PASO COUNTY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. § 30-11-103, the Board of County Commissioners of El Paso County, Colorado (hereinafter "Board") has the legislative authority to exercise the powers of the County when deemed to be in the best interests of the citizens of El Paso County; and

WHEREAS, on August 12, 1996, the Board approved Ordinance No. 96-3 Relating to the Control and Prevention of Graffiti in the Unincorporated Territory of El Paso County, recorded in the records of the El Paso County Clerk and Recorder's Office at Reception No. 96121429, which provided for the restraint and punishment of defacement of public and private property by juveniles; and

WHEREAS, the El Paso County Planning Department and the El Paso County Sheriff's Office has determined that Ordinance No. 96-3 is outdated and obsolete and no longer meets its intended purpose or adds any value to El Paso County; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that it would serve the best interests of the public for the El Paso County Sheriff's Office to investigate potential graffiti, destruction of property or such and pursue charges of those individuals utilizing stronger and more appropriate enforcement options under the Colorado Revised Statutes and the District Attorney's Office, thus obviating the need for Ordinance No. 96-3.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of El Paso County, State of Colorado, does hereby repeal Ordinance No. 96-3 recorded in the records of the El Paso County Clerk and Recorder's Office at Reception No. 96121429, as herein stated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Carrie Geitner, duly elected, qualified member and Chair of the Board of County Commissioners, or Lauren Nelson, duly elected, qualified member and Vice Chair of the Board of County Commissioners, be and is hereby authorized and appointed on behalf of the Board to execute any and all documents necessary to carry out the intent of the Board as described herein.
