


Unidentified Person

On October 13, 2024, partially skeletonized remains were found in the area of NB I-25 and Bijou St., Colorado Springs, Colorado.

Forensic anthropology examination suggests the decedent was a Male with African population affinity/ancestry, 37-73 years old (mean age of 54 years). Between 5'5" and 6 feet tall.

The decedent likely had Degenerative Idiopathic Skeletal Hyperostosis (DISH) and may have suffered from back pain, stiffness, or may have been asymptomatic. DISH is associated with gout, high cholesterol, or diabetes.
