


UNIDENTIFIED PERSON

On October 13, 2024, partially skeletonized remains were found in the area of Northbound I-25 and Bijou Street in Colorado Springs, Colorado.

Forensic anthropology examination suggests the decedent was male with potential ancestry among the African population. He was likely aged between 37 to 73 years old and stood between 5'5" and 6" tall.

This individual exhibited signs of Degenerative Idiopathic Skeletal Hyperostosis (DISH), so he may have suffered from back pain and stiffness. However, individuals with this condition may be asymptomatic. DISH is also associated with gout, high cholesterol, and/or diabetes.
