


UNIDENTIFIED PERSON

On October 8, 2020, a human skull was found in the Rampart Range area near Forest Service Roads 300 and 315. Forensic anthropology examination indicates that the individual was an adult Caucasian male of slight build. He is believed to have been deceased for 5 or more years prior to the discovery of his remains.

Dental examination revealed that the man had a small, cone-shaped (“peg”) tooth (upper lateral incisor) on his right side. Please note that despite the image above, he still had his front teeth prior to death.
