MINUTES

March 18th, 2026

Board Members: Chantel Bruce, Judge Amanda Philipps, Judge Cynthia McKedy, Brent Nelson, Deana O'Riley, Lt. Derek Mower, Manuela Reising, Lorena Gray, LeeAnn Ortega, Ryan Graham, and Jerry Jones.

1. **Chantel Bruce called the meeting to order at 12:17 p.m.** The Board meeting was held with members attending virtually or in person.

2. **Attendance:** Chantel Bruce called roll.

3. **Case Review:**

a. **VRA Statements:** Statements provided by victims or victim representatives.

b. **Discussion and Balloting:** No Discussion. Balloting was opened.

4. **Approval of Minutes and Presentation:**

a. **Judge McKedy moved, and Brent Nelson seconded the ratification of the meeting minutes for February 18th and the electronic meeting minutes for February 4th, 11th, and 25th, 2026; the motion passed unanimously by roll call vote.**

5. **Program Reports:**

a. **Embrave (ECC):** Mark Wester reported for Embrave; he reported that their residential average daily census in February was 294 with 245 beds allocated by DCJ; that the child support collected was \$4,851.45, and restitution collected was \$29,406.49; in a discussion with Board members regarding the marked increase in restitution collection, Mr. Wester indicated that this was due to it being tax season; he reported that Embrave had 45 admissions with 39 residential terminations during February; that the successful completion rate was 66.7%, totaling 26; that the negative terminations were 33.3%, totaling 13; the negative terminations included 15.4% for escapes, totaling six, and 17.9% for technical violations, totaling seven.

Mr. Wester reported that in February, Embrave received 51 Diversion and 55 Transition referrals; he reported that Embrave accepted 100% of auto Diversion referrals and 84% of

criteria Diversion referrals, as well as 100% of auto Transition referrals and 85% of criteria Transition referrals.

Mr. Wester reported that current staff vacancies include 10 security positions, three treatment staff positions, and two admin positions; Mr. Wester reported that the current client employment rate is 74.01%, and that the positive UA rate for the month is 3.5%; he reported that Embrave imposed 84 client sanctions and had four medical emergencies in February, along with receiving seven client grievances.

Mr. Wester stated that the DCJ would conduct a follow-up to its previous PACE audit of Embrave at the end of this month and confirmed that it would include the probationary review of the CRP program; that several frontline staff participated in hearing officer and room search guideline training during the month; that Embrave is currently using the Four Pillars model for clients, which includes instruction on financial literacy, job search skills, and professional presentation.

- b. **Community Alternatives of El Paso (CAE)**: Steve Owens reported for CAE; he reported that the bed count for February was 233, with 243 allocated by the Division of Criminal Justice (DCJ); that the total child support collected was \$4,548.00 and restitution was \$11,843.64; that there were 34 admissions and 37 terminations in February; that 22 clients successfully finished the program in February, yielding a successful program completion rate of 59.5%; that negative terminations numbered 15, yielding a negative termination rate of 40.5%, including 21.6% terminations for escapes, numbering eight, and 18.9% terminations for house/technical violations, numbering seven; Mr. Owens stated that the current client employment rate is 83.6%, and that the positive UA rate for the month is 5.5%; that CAE imposed 11 client sanctions in February; that there was one grievance and six medical emergencies; and that the current staff vacancies include three security positions.

Mr. Owens reported 46 Diversion and 40 Transition referrals in February; he reported that CAE accepted 100% of Diversion auto referrals and 79.4% of Diversion criteria referrals, and 100% of Transition auto referrals and 62.8% of Transition criteria referrals.

Mr. Owens reported that CAE is currently undergoing a flooring upgrade at their facility; that a resident concern was reported to the DCJ regarding residents' bikes being stolen from the facility; and in response, CAE has added locked fencing to the bike storage area to address the issue; Mr. Owens reported that CAE has monthly Community of Practice (CoP) meetings scheduled with Katie Coates from the DCJ; that to date, CAE reports meeting all expectations outlined in the PACE Corrective and KPIs for 2026; and that five case managers and one case manager supervisor attended the DCJ training regarding Community Supervision of Sex Offenders; that Case Management Supervisors have provided case managers with access to a self-auditing tool in order to prepare them for CAE's upcoming internal audit in April; that Security Staff have been learning each area of the shift, so everyone has the same knowledge; that security staff are carrying Narcan on their persons; that five total Narcan kits are available on each shift, to include additional

pouches for staff to sign out; and that a fidelity specialist has assisted operations by reviewing CAE's policies and assisting with file auditing.

6. Monthly Reports:

- a. **SFY25 Financial Report:** MaCain Hildebrand reported the billing documents (invoicing) for the January 2026 billing cycle as well as the documents for the February 2026 billing cycle; in January 2026, expenditures were expected to be at 58.33%; that Embrave was at \$4,260,465.58 expended, representing 5.23% overspent; that CAE was at \$3,911,196.93 expended, representing 0.02% overspent. In February 2026, expenditures were expected to be at 66.67%; that Embrave was at \$4,842,137.25 expended, representing 5.58% overspent; and that CAE was at \$4,392,697.11 expended, representing 1.13% underspent.
- b. **Provider Termination Report:** MaCain Hildebrand reported that for February 2026, Community Alternatives of El Paso County had a 59.46% positive/successful termination rate, an unauthorized absence termination rate of 21.62%, and a 18.92% technical violation termination rate; he reported that Embrave had a 65% positive/successful termination rate, a 17.5% unauthorized absence termination rate, and a 17.5% technical violation termination rate.
- c. **Staff Report:** MaCain Hildebrand reported that he met with leadership from the 4th Judicial District Probation Department, including Manager Lee Ann Ortega, on March 10th to discuss how the partnership and collaborations between Probation and Community Corrections Board staff are functioning; El Paso County is currently involved in its annual strategic planning process; the Division of Justice Services and Community Corrections are participating in the Department of Community Resources' overall planning efforts, helping to develop program-specific goals and objectives.

7. Old Business:

- a. **Bylaws Revision – 2nd Reading:** The proposed Bylaws amendments were presented for the 1st reading at the February 18, 2026, Community Corrections Board meeting. At this meeting, no additional changes were requested from the board. Judge McKedy moved, and Manuela Reising seconded the motion to approve the proposed revisions; **the motion passed by unanimous roll call vote.**

8. New Business:

- a. **CDOC - Victim Services Unit Supervisor Presentation** - The Board heard a presentation from Geriann Sanchez regarding the role of the CDOC Victim's Services Unit, and its responsibilities regarding victims' rights.

9. Case Review – Ballot Results: The Chair read the ballot results.


