1. Chantel Bruce called the meeting to order at 12:17 p.m. The Board meeting was held with members attending virtually or in person.

2. Attendance: Chantel Bruce called roll.

### 3. Case Review:

- a. VRA Statements: Statements provided by victims or victim representatives for offenders.
- b. Discussion and Balloting: No Discussion. Balloting was opened.

### 4. Approval of Minutes and Presentation:

a. Michael Publicker moved, and Lt. Derek Mower seconded ratifying the meeting minutes for April 16<sup>th</sup> and the electronic meeting minutes from April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup>, & 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025. The motion passed unanimously by roll call vote.

### 5. Program Reports:

a. Embrave (ECC): Mark Wester reported for Embrave; he reported that their residential average daily census in April was 277 with 234 beds allocated by DCJ; that the child support collected was \$4,974.28, and restitution collected was \$8,334.73; he reported that Embrave had 66 admissions with 64 residential terminations during April; that the successful completion rate was 56.3%, totaling 36; that the negative terminations were 43.8%, totaling 28; the negative terminations included 23.4% for escapes, totaling 15; 18.8% for technical violations, totaling 12; and 1.6% for committed new crime, totaling one.

Mr. Wester reported that Embrave received 63 Diversion and 50 Transition referrals in April; he reported that Embrave accepted 100% of auto Diversion referrals and 93% of criteria Diversion referrals, as well as 67% of auto Transition referrals and 87% of criteria Transition referrals.

Mark Wester reported that current staff vacancies include three security positions, three case manager positions, one treatment staff positions, and three support staff positions; Mr. Wester reported that the current client employment rate is 71.87%, and that the positive UA rate for the month is 1.8%; he reported that Embrave imposed 140 client sanctions in April; that there were seven medical emergencies during April; he reported that there were nine grievances; Embrave conducted a K9 search on April 14<sup>th</sup>.

Mark Wester reported on Embrave's prior 6-month IRT data, which shows a 65% successful program completion rate, with termination rates including 18% for Technical Violations and 12% for Unauthorized Absences.

Jenner Behan added that the IRT successful completions were comprised of individuals who completed the nine-week program; he stated that he will determine the recidivism rate for IRT clients; Embrave's overall recidivism rate is 29%.

b. Community Alternatives of El Paso (CAE): Evan Burton reported for CAE; Mr. Burton reported that their current bed count is 244, with 235 allocated by the Division of Criminal Justice (DCJ); that the total child support collected was \$4,600.00 and restitution was \$8,529.67; that there were 59 admissions and 33 terminations in April; that the successful program completion rate was 72.7%; and that the negative termination rate was 27.3%, which included six escapes and three technical house violations; he reported that there were four medical emergency incidents, and 17 client sanctions were imposed; he reported that the current staff vacancies include four security positions, and one case management position.

Mr. Burton reported 43 Diversion and 55 Transition referrals in April; CAE's client employment rate was 76.8%, and their UA positivity rate was 5.6%; he stated that the higher UA may be due to an increase in Diversion intakes.

Evan Burton reported that in April, the Case Manager Supervisors participated in the Crisis Intervention Treatment seminar sponsored by DCJ; that the April All Staff meeting included information and training in preparation for their upcoming PREA audit.

He reported that four clients graduated from the IRT program in April, and there have been 32 graduates since the program started over a year ago; CAE will work to compile IRT data for the past six months to present to the board.

### 6. Monthly Reports:

a. **SFY24 Financial Report:** MaCain Hildebrand reported that the April 2025 expenditures were expected to be at 83.33%; that Embrave was at \$5,754,877.40 expended, representing 2.53% overspent; and that CAE was at \$5,346,807.85 expended, representing 2.34% underspent.

- b. **Provider Termination Report**: MaCain Hildebrand reported that for April 2025, Community Alternatives of El Paso County had a 72.73% positive/successful termination rate, a 18.18% unauthorized absence termination rate, and a 9.09% technical violation termination rate; he reported that Embrave had a 56.25% positive/successful termination rate, a 23.44% unauthorized absence termination rate, a 13.73% technical violation termination rate, and a 1.56% new crime termination rate.
- c. <u>Staff Report:</u> MaCain Hildebrand reported that Justice Services received approval for technical assistance from the National Institute of Corrections (NIC) to help determine and implement improved methods and best practices for data collecting and reporting within community corrections.

### 7. Old Business:

None for this month.

- 8. New Business:
  - a. <u>Sex Offense Sentencing and Supervision:</u> Board member and Supervising Deputy Public Defender Deana O'Riley, along with Probation Officer Ron Newman, discussed sex offense convictions, sentencing requirements, and intensive supervision as they relate to community corrections with the board.
  - b. <u>Community Corrections 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter SFY25 Referral Data:</u> MaCain Hildebrand reported on the SFY25 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter referral trends and acceptance data; he reported that the board reviewed 299 out of the total 548 referrals received; this included 228 transition referrals, 264 diversion referrals, 30 condition of parole referrals, one ISP-I direct referrals, and 25 condition of probation referrals; Mr. Hildebrand reported that this board had the highest acceptance rate for transition clients in the state of Colorado.
- 9. Case Review Ballot Results: The Chair read the ballot results.
