1. Chantel Bruce called the meeting to order at 12:15 p.m. The Board meeting was held with members attending virtually or in person.

2. Attendance: Chantel Bruce called roll.

3. Case Review:

- a. VRA Statements: Statements provided by victims or victim representatives for offenders.
- b. **Discussion and Balloting:** No Discussion. Balloting was opened.

4. Approval of Minutes and Presentation:

a. Brent Nelson moved, and Lt. Robert Harris seconded, ratifying the meeting minutes for August 20th and September 17th and the electronic meeting minutes from August 6th, 13th & 27th, and September 3rd, 10th, & 24th, 2025; the motion passed unanimously by roll call vote.

5. Program Reports:

a. Embrave (ECC): Jenner Behan reported for Embrave; he reported that their residential average daily census in September was 296 with 235 beds allocated by DCJ; that the child support collected was \$3,451.00, and restitution collected was \$3,208.81; he reported that Embrave had 72 admissions with 39 residential terminations during September; that the successful completion rate was 61.5%, totaling 24; that the negative terminations were 38.5%, totaling 15; the negative terminations included 25.6% for escapes, totaling 10; 10.3% for technical violations, totaling four, and 2.6% for new crimes committed, totaling one.

Mr. Behan reported that Embrave received 40 Diversion and 56 Transition referrals in September; he reported that Embrave accepted 87.5% of auto Diversion referrals and 84.4% of criteria Diversion referrals, as well as 100% of auto Transition referrals and 86%

of criteria Transition referrals; that Embrave's client employment rate was 82.5% and their UA positivity rate was 3.7% in September.

Mr. Behan reported that current staff vacancies include two security positions, one case management positions, one administrative position, and three support staff positions; Mr. Behan reported that the current client employment rate is 73.19%, and that the positive UA rate for the month is 1.2%; he reported that Embrave imposed 118 client sanctions in September; that there were eight medical emergencies during September; he reported 18 client grievances.

Mr. Behan stated that the RDDT program has reopened at Embrave and provided clarification to the Board on the program's specific purpose; Mr. Behan reported that Embrave conducted corrective training sessions with staff on whereabouts checks and contraband on 9/5/25, 9/24/25, 9/30/25, and 10/8/25; he noted that Embrave has reorganized positions, including a Client Program manager and two Client Program Leads; that Embrave has reassigned Ben Motaei to provide on-the-job training, conduct compliance audits, and serve as a PREA investigator; Mr. Motaei was present and introduced to the Board by Mr. Behan.

Mr. Behan spoke to the Board members about Embrave's KPI's; he stated that at the end of Q3, Embrave's involuntary staff turnover rate was below the 32% benchmark stated on their KPI, with a rate of 14%; that the Q3 average length of stay for staff members was above the KPI benchmark of three years, with an average of 3.9 years; that through Q3, Embrave has provided staff with seven unique kinds of training sessions, passing the KPI benchmark of seven; that in Q3, 92.1% of staff identified themselves as having adequate training, surpassing the KPI benchmark of 75%.

b. Community Alternatives of El Paso (CAE): Steve Owens reported for CAE; he reported that their current bed count is 250, with 240 allocated by the Division of Criminal Justice (DCJ); that the total child support collected was \$2,626.00 and restitution was \$6,130.00; that there were 37 admissions and 34 terminations in September; that the successful program completion rate was 55.9%; and that the negative termination rate was 44.1%, which included eight escapes, seven technical/house violations, and one warrant/pending crime prior to placement; he reported that there were 16 medical emergency incidents and 142 client sanctions imposed; he reported that the current staff vacancies include three security positions and two case management positions; Mr. Owens stated that CAE graduated three clients from their IRT program in September.

Mr. Owens reported 40 Diversion and 56 Transition referrals in September; he reported that CAE accepted 87.5% of Diversion auto referrals, and 84.3% of Diversion criteria referrals; that CAE accepted 100% of Transition auto referrals and 86% of Transition criteria referrals in September; that CAE's client employment rate was 75.9% and their UA positivity rate was 2.3% in September.

Mr. Owens reported that in September, CAE conducted a GEO internal audit, and that case managers participated in virtual training with GEO's corporate office; Mr. Owens also

stated that, for their skill development through directed practice, they focused on staff demonstrating milieu management for effective role modeling and responsivity; Mr. Owens indicated that September's All Staff meeting included training on ADA, Lockout, Tagout, Conflict Resolution, and De-escalation.

6. Monthly Reports:

- a. **SFY24 Financial Report:** MaCain Hildebrand reported that through the end of September, SFY expenditures should be at 25%; he reported that Embrave was at \$1,807,832.35 expended, representing 1.97% overspent; and that CAE was at \$1,672,638.98 expended, representing 0.04% underspent.
- b. **Provider Termination Report**: MaCain Hildebrand reported that for September 2025, Community Alternatives of El Paso County had a 55.88% positive/successful termination rate, a 23.53% unauthorized absence termination rate, and a 20.59% technical violation termination rate; he reported that Embrave had a 61.54% positive/successful termination rate, a 23.08% unauthorized absence termination rate, a 12.82% technical violation termination rate, and a 2.56% negative terminations; committed new crime rate.
- c. <u>Staff Report:</u> MaCain Hildebrand thanked all board members who were able to attend the Board Retreat on October 10th. Mr. Hildebrand stated that Community Corrections Board Staff will be attending the 2025 Office of Community Corrections Annual Conference on October 21st and 22nd; Mr. Hildebrand also indicated to the board that they had been provided copies of a summary of the Correctional Treatment Funds (CTF) for use by programs funded by the Division of Criminal Justice, Office of Community Corrections, for their reference.

7. Old Business:

a. <u>Community Corrections Board Support Plan:</u> No official actions or votes were taken during the September 17th, 2025, board meeting due to the absence of a quorum; as a result, agenda item 7a was re-presented to the board, seeking approval.

The DCJ's Office of Community Corrections (OCC) has directed Board Staff to develop a support plan that requires additional oversight of Embrave's operations, as recommended by the DCJ following their August 14th audit; MaCain Hildebrand spoke to the board about the specifics of the sanctions imposed on Embrave and the corrective action plan; Mark Allison spoke to the board about El Paso County's support plan for Embrave, which was submitted to the DCJ's OCC on September 29th, 2025.

Judge Cynthia McKedy moved, and Michael Publicker seconded the ratification of the submission of the Community Corrections Board Support Plan to the DCJ-OCC. The motion passed by unanimous roll-call vote.

b. Out of District Diversion Referrals – Temporary Moratorium: No official actions or votes were taken during the September 17th, 2025, board meeting due to the absence of a quorum. As a result, agenda item 7b was re-presented seeking board approval.

MaCain Hildebrand spoke to the board about the temporary suspension of reviewing out-of-district direct sentence diversion cases, effective September 3rd, 2025; he stated that the aim is to increase the number of transition referrals reviewed by the CCB each week; out-of-district referrals for DCJ-authorized special programming (IRT, CRP, and RDDT) will continue to be accepted; board staff will continue to monitor the CCB transition waitlist for a decrease in numbers; board staff will report this data at monthly CCB meetings to determine when the temporary suspension can be lifted; Mr. Hildebrand spoke with the board regarding where these out-of-district referrals are coming from.

Lieutenant Derek Mower moved, and Judge Cynthia McKedy seconded the ratification of the temporary moratorium on out-of-district referrals. The motion passed by unanimous roll-call vote.

 - a. No new business was presented to the board at this meeting.
- 9. Case Review Ballot Results: The Chair read the ballot results. Board/Staff Comments: None.
